

SAWBRIDGEWORTH MEMORIAL HALL – COVID COMPLIANCE

On your return to classes at our hall, you will notice some changes to allow social distancing. We will be operating the hall in line with government and ACRE (advisors to village halls) guidelines.

Social distancing

2 metre spacing markers on the floor have been put in place in the main hall.

To allow social distancing the only toilet that is currently in use will be the disabled one.

There is a one way in and out system in place with gel at both points.

Please remind your class then exiting to the car park to be careful of cars driving through.

It is possible to use the front garden to exit but if you do this then please provide your own gel and to ensure that you do not meet a class coming into the hall after yours.

Where a class is engaged in physical activities eg keep fit, the government recommends a distancing of 1 person per 16 sqm metres.

The main hall is 160sqm ie 10 people are allowed with the teacher on the stage.

Cleaning

Cleaning of the hall will happen each evening. All hirers will be expected to wipe door handles and light switches when they start and finish their class. The hall will not be employing cleaners between classes but if you feel that is needed before your class, then we either ask you to do this yourselves.

As classes are back to back please ensure that your class ends at an appropriate time to allow for you to carry out any task required.

Ventilation

There are many doors at our venue please ensure doors are left open as appropriate for your class. AND closed shut afterwards.

Kitchen

Should not be used at these times.
